Dear Mr. Mandel:

Mr. Warren Pyle, my lawyer, is on vacation for three weeks. Last evening, Mr. Pyle faxed me the attached amended agreement with Emmanuel College. I agree with it except for one sentence which I have deleted; namely, "The College confirms that it did not indefinitely suspend or dismiss Dr. Beauchesne from the College."

I cannot in good conscience sign an agreement with that sentence in it because, in doing so, I would become an accomplice to Sr. Janet Eisner's perjuring herself. On May 7, 1999, Sr. Janet Eisner did say to me -- reading from hand written notes on a yellow pad -- that I had two choices: (1) to be indefinitely suspended from Emmanuel College or (2) to be dismissed from Emmanuel College. It is only in a May 10, 1999 fax that she sent me at home that she used the expression 'voluntary retirement.'
