For the third time (May 7, May 10 & today, May 20), I am asking you to make available to me in typed form (but without any revision) the accusations you read to me as well as the punishments you imposed upon me (between 1.30 PM and 2.30 PM, Friday, May 14, 1999), which were scribbled on a yellow pad in front of you and read to me between 1.30 PM & 2.20 P.M.

I also want a copy of the P&T letter written against me (which you read to me). Furthermore, I want any allegations you made against me (on May 10<sup>7</sup>) to be substantiated with the relevant referenced sections in the 1989 Handbook (& approved Update), including the names of the accusers and the nature of their accusation. Every single allegation you make against me must be substantiated with copies of primary/original sources and/or Said Faculty Handbook.

Failure to respond to this request IMMEDIATELY (that means by 4.40 PM, Friday, May 21) might mean that you and Pat will be served a legal notice on the part of my lawyer.
